Tips for attending Open Events and Making Applications

- Try to visit as many colleges on their open events as you can. It is best to visit too many than miss ones that you later wish you had visited.
- It is possible to apply for as many colleges as you like. You will need to have an interview for all the colleges you apply for, this may be in person or by phone/online.
- When you apply to a college you do not need to have narrowed down your choice of subjects/courses (some colleges let you apply to up to 6 courses). You can narrow down your choices after discussion in your interview.
- If you make applications to multiple colleges you will have until Enrolment to decide which college you want to go to. Enrolment takes place the week after you get your GCSE Results in August. You will enrol at the **one** college you want to go to.
- College applications are made online (if you would prefer to fill in a paper application this is also available). Applications for most colleges open in September/October 2022. Remember that the deadline for college applications is **Christmas 2022**.

Careers Support in Year 11

The Careers Team is made up of the following people: Mrs Rance (Careers Adviser) and Mr West (Careers Lead). We are based in the Careers Office, room 2.10 which is located in the Art corridor (opposite Media classroom 2.09).

During Year 11 you will have access to the following support:

- Individual Careers Guidance Interviews with Mrs Rance, Careers Adviser (*Please speak to your Tutor if you would like to request an early Careers Guidance Interview*). Everyone in Year 11 will have the opportunity to have a Careers Guidance Interview.
- Talks by representatives from the local 6th forms, colleges and apprenticeship providers.
- Careers Drop-in appointments for quick queries in the Careers Office at lunchtime on Thursdays.
- Careers Fair in School (usually during Parents evenings) – giving students and parents the opportunity to collect prospectuses and speak to representatives from local colleges and apprenticeship providers
